General Guidelines to Eyesight and Hearing Requirements for the Maritime Field

NOTE! These eyesight and hearing requirements are based on the Finnish law 80/1985 http://www.tyosuojelu.fi/fi/s19850070/1123 (page in Finnish). This is an unofficial translation of the requirements, meant to serve as general guidelines for applicants. Always consult your seaman's healthcare station (physician/doctor) for accurate information about current requirements for seamen!

EYESIGHT

A seaman should have normal colour vision and should meet the following requirements when they are given an eyesight test with the Snellen eye chart (E-chart):
