

## General Guidelines to Eyesight and Hearing Requirements for the Maritime Field

**NOTE!** These eyesight and hearing requirements are based on the Finnish law 80/1985

### EYESIGHT

A seaman should have normal colour vision and should meet the following requirements when they are given an eyesight test with the Snellen eye chart (E-chart) :

### HEARING

A seaman should have the following ability to hear without a hearing aid, unless otherwise specified;
